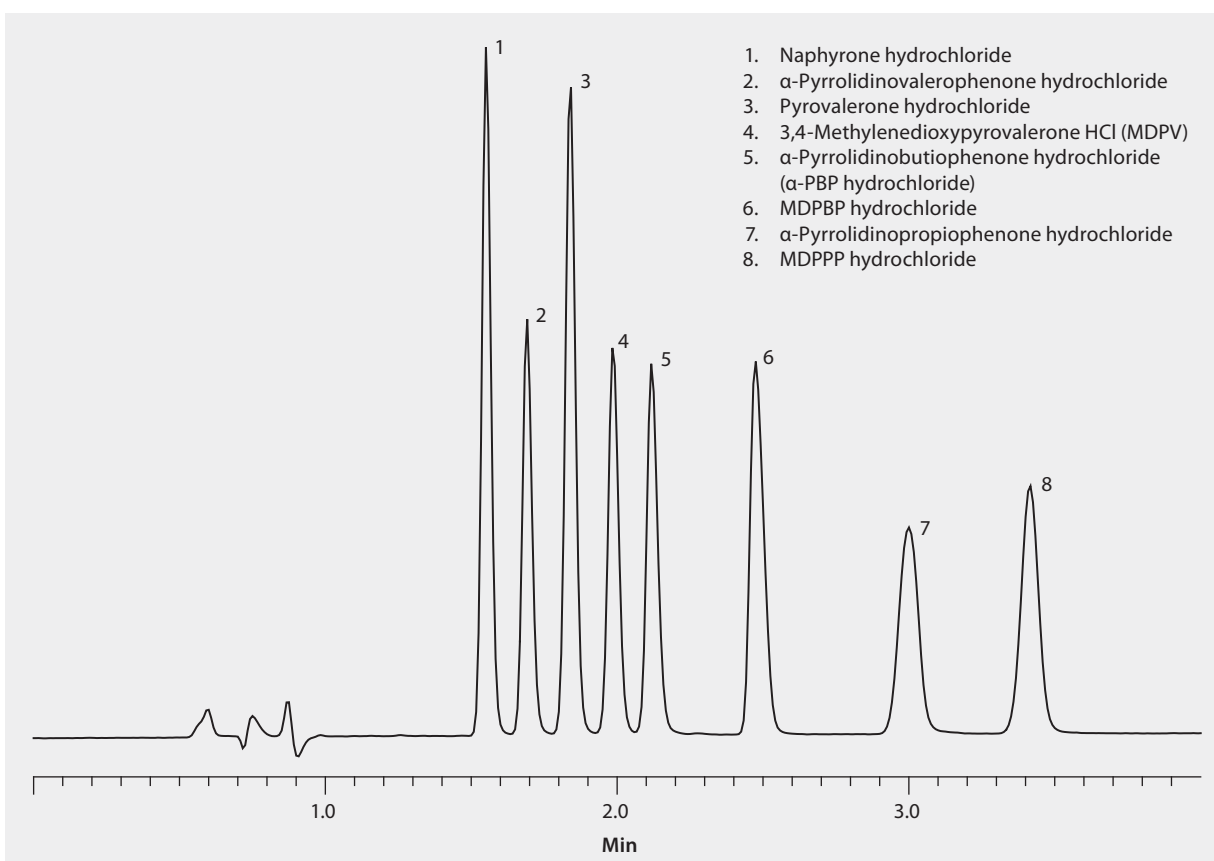


UHPLC Analysis of Flakka Compounds on Ascentis® Express HILIC

The rapid separation of the street drug Flakka (α -PVP) and related compounds is shown here on an Ascentis Express HILIC column. Highest grade UHPLC solvents were used to supply low background interference and low particulate contamination for robust, trouble-free operation. Cerilliant CRMs provided reliable identification and quantification.
